PART 03

Your Core Connection

This section looks at Sun, Moon, and Saturn between the two of you: the planets tied to identity, feeling, and the steadiness two people build over time. These are usually the first things a couple notices about each other, often before either can name why. What follows describes the texture of that recognition, not how strong or lasting it will turn out to be, since that depends on far more than any chart can hold.

Emma Carter's Saturn square Marco Santini's Mercury, orb 0.3 degrees

A passing comment can meet a wall of doubt under this contact, even when nothing critical was intended. Whoever carries Mercury may feel that every idea gets questioned before it has a chance to breathe, and whoever carries Saturn may feel that ideas keep arriving too fast and

loosely reasoned to trust yet. A conversation about something small can slow down while one side tests it and the other waits for approval that is slow in coming. What helps between two people is treating that caution as a request for more grounding, not as a verdict on the thought itself, since this contact rewards patience with the pace far more than it rewards rushing an answer.

PART 04

Where You Land in Each Other's World

A chart divides the sky into twelve rooms, and this section checks which of six especially telling ones, identity, home, romance, partnership, shared change, and public direction, each of you steps into for the other. The overlay runs both ways, so you will see where your planets land in their rooms and where theirs land in yours. It is a location, not a rating of how that room turns out to feel.

Emma Carter's Moon in Marco Santini's 7th House

Emotional need becomes a central feature of the partnership itself when a partner's Moon lands in the seventh house, since this house governs the relationship as its own subject rather than as one part of a fuller life. The house owner tends to feel this bond as an actual source of comfort, somewhere feelings can land safely rather than somewhere they have to be managed. That is a significant kind of closeness, and it also means the relationship can start carrying more emotional weight

than any one connection can sustainably hold on its own. Other sources of comfort, close friends, personal rituals, quiet time alone, deserve to stay active alongside this bond rather than fading out of the picture. Keeping that balance is what lets this placement's warmth stay sustainable instead of becoming the only place feelings are allowed to go.

Marco Santini's Mars in Emma Carter's 1st House

A noticeable jolt of energy shows up when a partner's Mars lands in the house owner's first house, since this house governs how someone shows up and Mars brings drive and directness straight into that presentation. The house owner may find themselves more assertive, more physically alert, quicker to act, specifically around this one person, in ways that can feel either invigorating or a little overwhelming depending on the day. There is real vitality in this contact, the kind that pushes both of you to actually do things rather than just discuss them. What is worth watching is whether that energy occasionally reads as pressure rather than as encouragement, since Mars pushes and the first house is sensitive to being pushed. Naming the difference between a challenge and a genuine push toward action keeps this energy welcome rather than confrontational.
