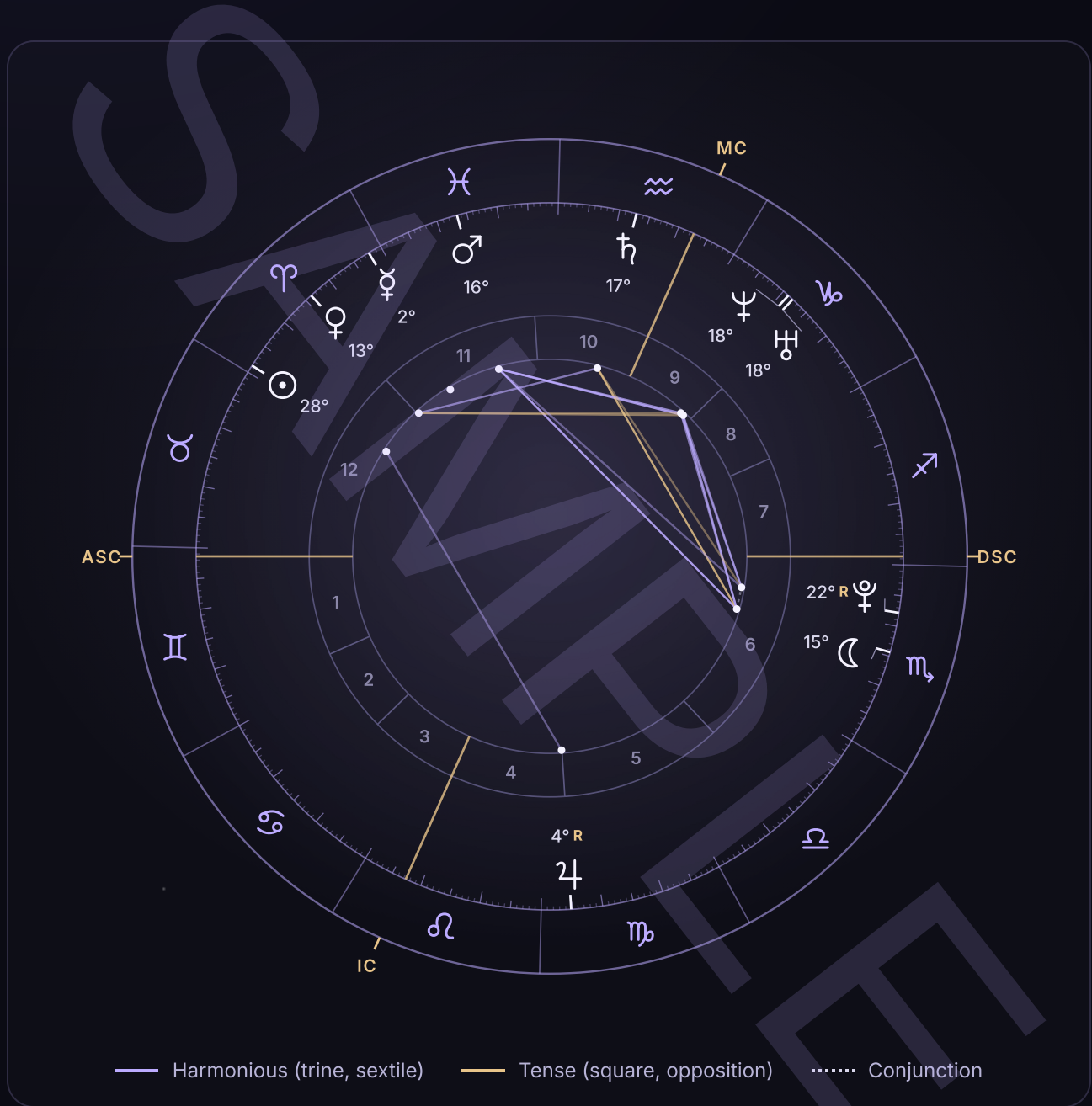

The Big Three

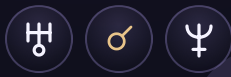


Sun in Aries

Your timing under sudden change is good; disruption sharpens you rather than scattering you.

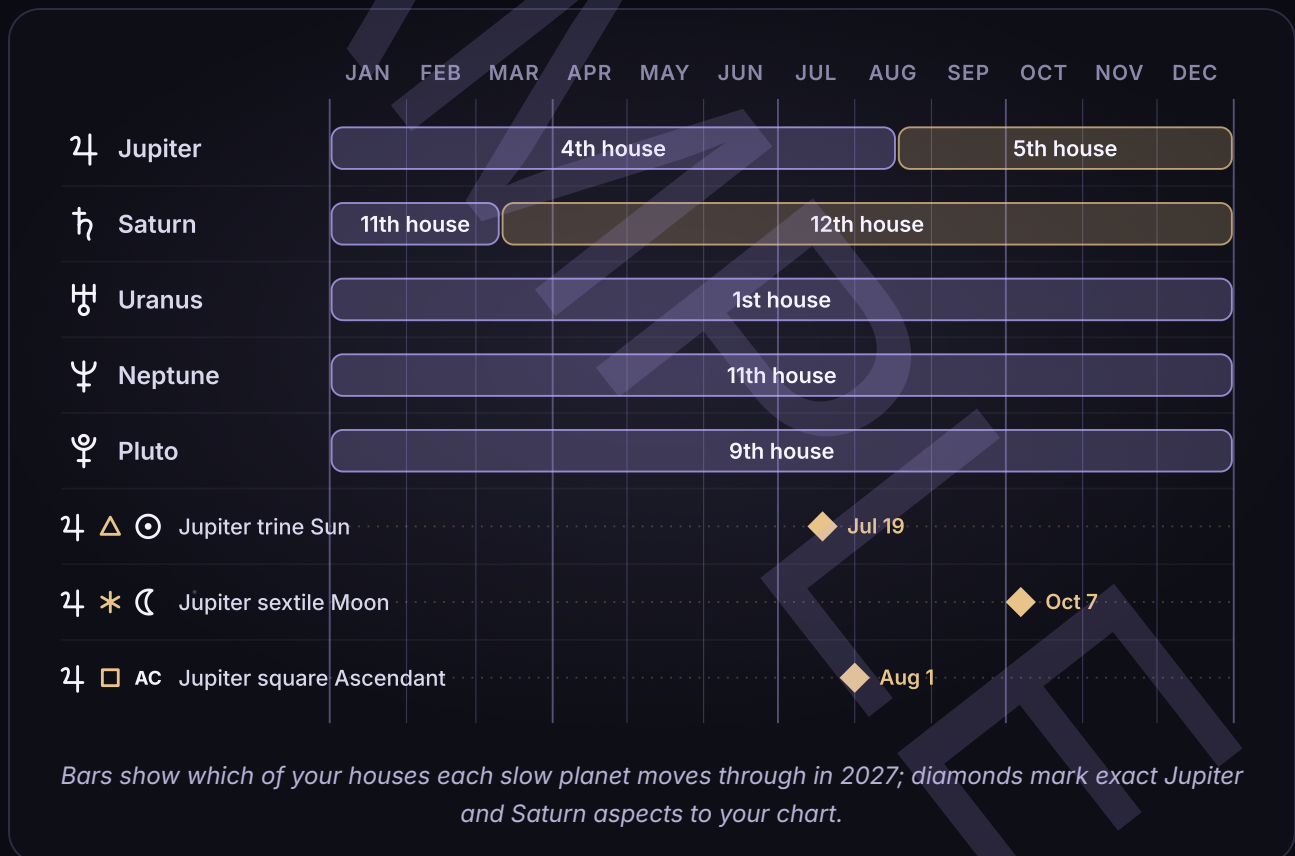

How to Read This Report

Three placements do most of the introducing, Emma Carter: a Aries Sun for the core of you, a Scorpio Moon for what you need in private, and Gemini on the ascendant for the way you arrive.

Hold them loosely as you read. The rest of the report fills in the detail, and some of it will complicate this opening sketch rather than confirm it.

This report describes tendencies, not events. Nothing here is a forecast of what will occur, and nothing in a birth chart removes your choice about how to handle what it describes.

You may also find sections that seem to contradict each other. That is not an error; people are genuinely made of competing parts. What follows is a table of your positions, then chapters organized by theme.
